

Traditional Hawaiian Applique

Class project is a 18in. pillow. Learn the traditional art of Hawaiian applique with the history and superstitions that created the unique symmetrical quilts. This is a hand work class.

Supply List

- 1. Fabric 1 20in. square of background fabric, 1 -1/2 yard applique fabric (leaf), 1-10in. square (flower fabric).
- 2. Sharp 6-8in. fabric scissors, paper scissors
- 3. Hand Applique thread to match your applique fabrics, leaf and flower. 60-50wt cotton, polyester or silk.
- 4. Hand Applique needles (a variety size pack is best)
- 5. Basting thread and needle
- 6. One 8.5" x 11" approx.. freezer paper
- 7. Chalk pencils and a regular pencil
- 8. Straight pins
- 9. Portable light (for handwork) -optional

All supplies and a kit will be available for sale during class. This is optional – you may bring your own supplies or purchase them during class.

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
