

## Color Me Quilts- Chameleons 2020 Techniques with Inktense pencils, watercolor pencils and more! Full day Class with Desiree!

Come and join me for a fun filled day learning multiple techniques for applying colored pencils to fabric with amazing results. No artistic skill is required, I will bring almost everything you need for your class so you can just show up and enjoy the day. I will be teaching you the secrets for creating an appliqué look with colored pencil, watercolor pencils and more. In my *FULL* day class you will be given a pre-quilted block from my newest embroidery CD, Color Me Quilts. These are some of my sketches from Sugar Hill Farms Flowers recreated as stitch files just for you to color! You will have your choice of several designs. I will be teaching you faux finishing techniques like marbling along with blending to give a more realistic look to your designs and how to create textures. We will be playing with stamps and stencils and exploring different options with your pencils. Once sealed these pieces become washable and permanent. Its tons of fun and they can be applied to your art quilts or traditional quilts to add details and textures.

I will be giving you ideas for how to use your blocks and my Table runner pattern too! There will be a \$45.00 kit fee which will include use of all my supplies plus your pre-quilted/prestitched block, 5 Inktense Pencils, Textile medium, brushes, container and papertowel.



## **Supply List – Suggestion but not mandatory**


- 1. Notepad and pen to take notes/pencil
- 2. Feel free to bring any colored pencils you might have.

## **Included in your Kit fee for Art Applique**

- 1. Your kit will consist of a large pre-quilted/pre-stitched block for you to learn the coloring techniques I talked about on Quilting Arts TV and in the Quilting Arts Magazine. Your choice of two different Chameleons
- 2. 5 Inktense Pencils depending on which block you choose.
- 3. My Tablerunner Pattern.
- 4. Textile Medium
- 5. Brushes
- 6. Paper towels and a container
- 7. The use of all of my other art supplies and pencils during class to complete your block.

I will be bringing everything you need to work on your block, you are welcome to bring any pencils or supplies you have but you are still responsible for the kit fee.

<u>Colored pencils</u> bring what ever you have. I prefer Inktense pencils by Derwent or Prismacolor and they are available at Michaels and most Art stores. I will have all of my colored pencils, watercolor pencils and textile medium available for your use in class only. If you bring yours please make sure they are marked as to not get confused with mine



<u>Pre-Quilted block</u>, -your kit fee will cover a pre-quilted/pre-stitched block from one of my art sketches.

I will be teaching you different painting techniques using colored pencils and watercolor pencils. I will provide the pencils for you to use during class.

## You will learn:

- Color selection
- Blending
- Shading
- How to apply the pencil
- Sealing
- Marbleizing and so much more.
- Using Intense Bars
- Using Stamps and stencils

This is going to be a fun filled day of creative coloring!

This simple technique is so much fun, once you learn it you can apply to other surfaces, other

projects. Depending on how quickly you work you should take home a nearly completed block, ready to finish as you like.
